Consent and Acknowledgement

I, the undersigned, certify that I am the owner or authorized agent for the owner of the above-named pet. I hereby give my consent and authorization to the veterinarian and staff of **Knight Vet Clinic** to perform euthanasia for my pet.

I understand that euthanasia involves the administration of medication to end my pet's life peacefully and without pain, and that once performed, the procedure is irreversible.

I further acknowledge and agree to the following:

1. **Irreversibility:** I understand the decision to euthanize is final and cannot be undone.
2. **Medical Information:** I have provided all known relevant medical history regarding my pet.
3. **Legal Authority:** I am the legal owner or have the legal authority to consent to this procedure.

4. **Risks & Reactions:** While rare, there may be minor physical reactions (e.g., muscle twitches, urination) after the procedure, which are natural and do not indicate pain.
5. **Remains & Aftercare:** I have selected the aftercare option below and understand the related fees.

Aftercare Options Cremation Services (Select One)

Home Burial – I will take my pet's remains home for burial.

Disposal by clinic- I would like the clinic to dispose of my pets remains.

We offer three cremation options to meet the needs and preferences of our clients:

1. Communal Cremation

Multiple pets are cremated together, and individual ashes are not returned. The combined remains are respectfully transported to Donnelly, where they are spread throughout the tree farm.

Communal Cremation – My pet will be cremated with other pets; ashes will not be returned.

2. Segregated Private Cremation

More than one pet is placed in the cremation chamber at the same time; however, each pet is separated to ensure their remains can be individually collected. Pets **DO NOT** come into contact with one another during the process.

Segregated Private Cremation- My pet will be cremated with other pets but **DO NOT** come in contact with other pets; ashes will be returned to me.

3. Private Cremation

Only one pet is placed in the chamber for cremation, ensuring complete separation. All ashes returned are exclusively those of your pet.

Private Cremation – My pet will be cremated individually; ashes returned to me.
